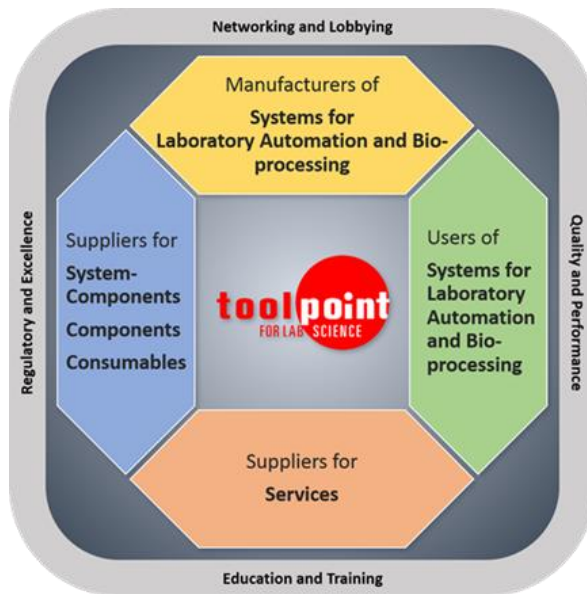


Profile
